The flow of the game is as follows: during the daytime, the monk explores the streets of Edo gathering information; at night, he fights alongside his fellow monks and a group of novice monks. In a tight spot, a secret killer technique is unleashed with a flashy cut in, turning the tide of battle; the story unfolds delivering poetical justice and a moral drawing upon the typical period drama.
