GignoSystem Japan Provision of an official mobile site of a movie “red letters” on the mobile site “Visual Boy”

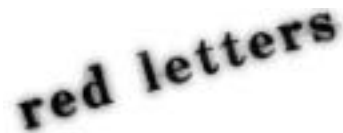
